

W 29th Ave & Speer Blvd Sanitary

Louisiana Ave & S Pearl St Intersection Improvements

- **Hard Bid Project**
 - Advertise Q3 2022
- **29th & Speer Sanitary Improvements**
 - Remove and replace 2 runs (manhole to manhole) of existing sanitary sewer in Speer Blvd from W 29th Ave to Bryant St
 - Speer Blvd is a major thoroughfare into and out of the City
 - North High School
- **Louisiana Ave & S Pearl St Intersection Improvements**
 - Intersection has history of flooding adjacent businesses
 - Improve stormwater capacity of roadway
 - Remove existing inlets and replace with infrastructure meeting current construction standards
 - Tie into existing storm main in Louisiana Ave
- **Construction estimate \$4 million (for both locations)**

Bowles Ditch Separation Ph1

Hard Bid Project

- Advertise Q3 2022

Phase I includes:

- 1050 feet of 42- and 48-inch storm main with laterals and inlets
- Sanitary sewer and water line adjustments
- Piping the Bowles Lateral via 60-inch pipe for 187 linear feet
- Headwall and wingwall construction
- Curb ramps
- Curb, gutter, and sidewalk replacement
- Associated roadway reconstruction and landscape rehabilitation

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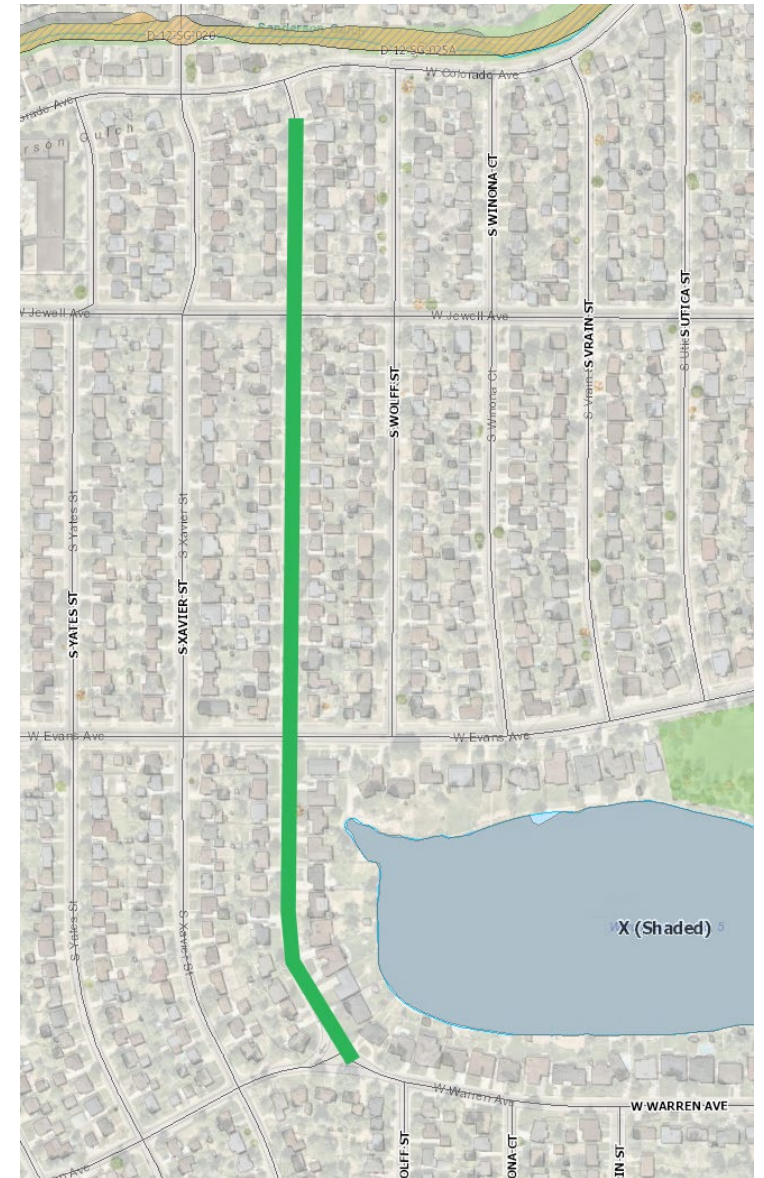
South Federal Green Blvd Project

- **Hard Bid Project**
 - Advertise Q3 2022
- **Scope:**
 - Project will provide water quality treatment for storm runoff along South Federal Blvd. between W. Alameda Ave. and Tenn. Ave.
- **Sixty (60!) Streetside Stormwater Planters**
 - Avg. SSP size 8' x 30'
- **3 Hydrodynamic Separators**
- **Significant flatwork**



South Wolcott at Sanderson Gulch Storm and Sanitary Replacement

- **Hard Bid Project**
 - Advertise Q4 2022
- This project will replace an existing storm drain and sanitary sewer in southwest Denver.
- The two systems are in conflict and need to be separated for water quality purposes.
- Open cut construction of 36" RCP and 8" PVC, lateral pipes, inlets, manholes, and other drainage structures.
 - ~2500 LF 8" PVC
 - ~2700 LF 36" RCP
- Other work includes waterline relocation and surface restoration.

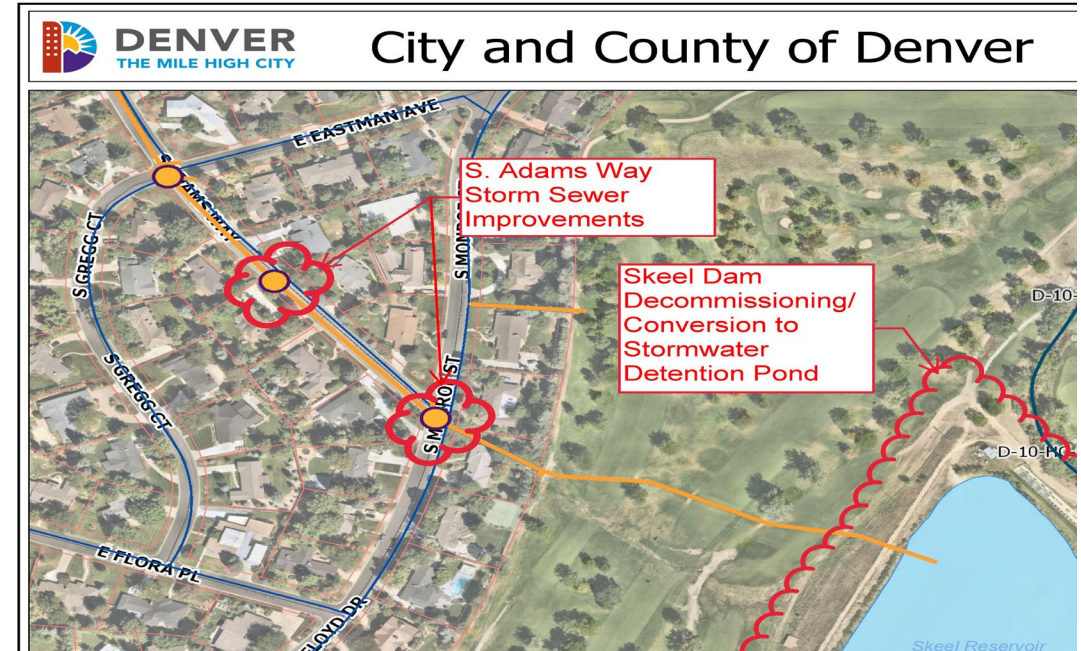


General Storm – Antero Peak

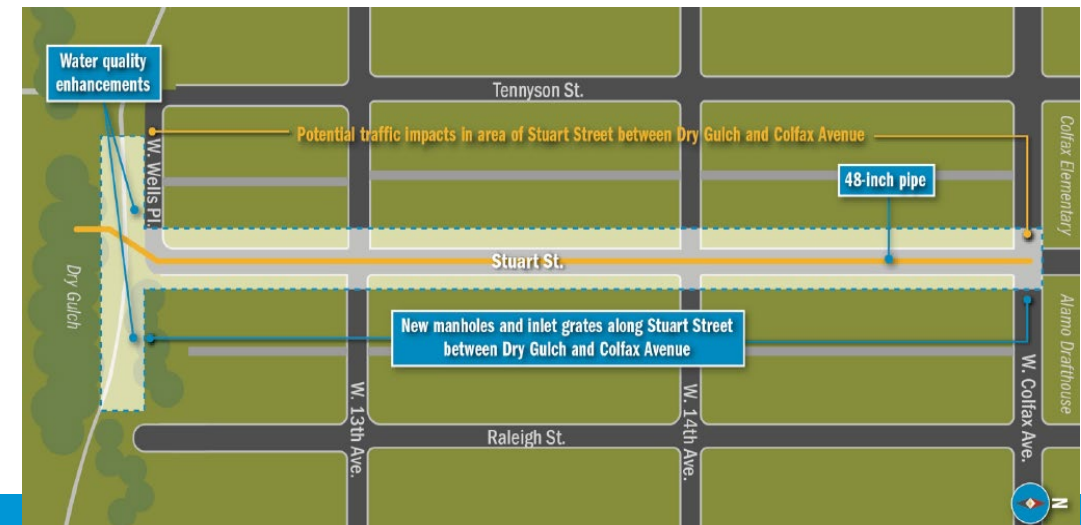
Location 1: South Adams Way

- Improvements downstream of Skeel Reservoir
- 200 LF of 18-21" RCP storm laterals, inlets and manholes
- Associated roadway reconstruction and landscape restoration



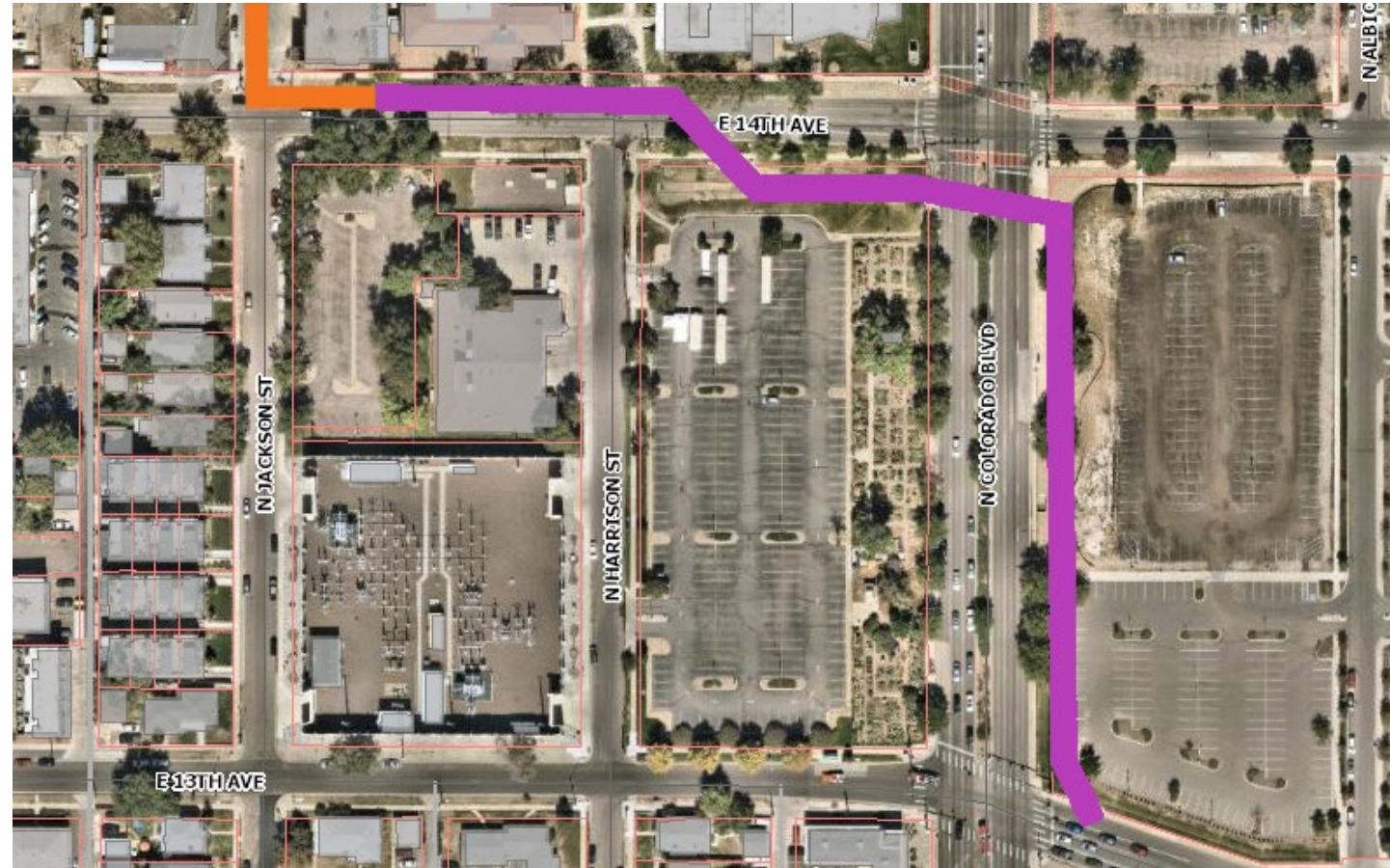
Location 2: Stuart St. System

- 2000 LF of 48" RCP storm main with laterals, inlets, and manholes
- Outfall to Dry Gulch
- Trash vault
- Roadway reconstruction, curb ramps, sidewalks



Jackson Street Storm Sewer – Phase 2

- **Hard Bid**
 - Advertise Q2 2023
- **Continuation of Jackson St Storm Ph 1**
 - 1,000 LF 120-inch RCP
 - 150 LF Dual Tunnel Under CO Blvd
 - Associated Paving/Frontage Improvements
 - Anticipated NTP = Q3 2022
