General Project Guidelines

Doing Business with Aurora Water

1. Rocky Mountain Purchasing (BidNet)
 1. Require Prequalification of contractors for each project
2. Automatic Notifications
3. Bids – Received and Time Stamped - BidNet



T&D Projects

1. Approximately \$15M annually for T&D Construction

2. Annual programs for:

- Rehab Water Mains ~ \$7M Currently Being Advertised
- Rehab Valve and Water Vaults ~ \$2M - 2Q Annually
- New Water Mains ~ \$5M – 2Q Annually
- Buckley Air Force Base PRV Relocation ~ \$1.5M - 3Q 2022
- Murphy Creek Connection Vault ~ \$1.5M – 3Q 2022

3. Various locations throughout the City

 1. Advertising in June
2. First Creek connector to Prologis ~\$500K
 1. Advertising July/Aug
3. First Creek Interceptor – Bid Package 2 ~\$34M
 1. Advertising September
4. SC11/SC10 E Colfax to N Laredo ~\$8M
 1. Advertising November
